## INTRODUCTION TO NENE VALLEY AEROMODELLERS

Nene Valley Aeromodellers (NVA) are a group of enthusiasts enjoying a range of activities associated with fixed-wing and helicopter aero-modelling. The club was founded in the early 1970s and caters for many aspects of model flying including power, scale, glider, sports and electric. One of the newer interests is the flying of multi-rotor (e.g. quad-copters); some members have taken impressive videos of the site and the surrounding countryside.

Our annual membership is usually about 60 to 70 people, both adults and juniors.

Members new to model flying are always welcome and experienced members are always willing to advise you on initial model set-up. Flight training by experienced pilots is available at no additional cost to members. This can be with your own aircraft or the club's own trainer. The club organises examinations for flying proficiency certificates through its affiliation with the British Model Flying Association (BMFA).

During the year there are a number of competitions, usually held on Sundays at the club's superb 3.7 acre field between Olney and Yardley Hastings, just off the B5388. Parking in the summer months is just a short walk from the pits but the site has a large hard standing, off road car park for use in the winter months.

A host of information including flying times and rules are published on the club's website [www.flynva.org](http://www.flynva.org). The best time for potential members to visit the field is on a Sunday morning 10 am - 1 pm but attendance varies depending on weather conditions. If you plan to make a special trip to the field you might like to telephone one of the committee members to make an arrangement, however you are welcome to come along and take a chance.

## HOW TO FIND US

The field is situated next to the B5388 between Yardley Hastings and Olney. Please take care when turning into the field itself as the turning is situated in the middle of a sharp bend and visibility is poor.

From Olney the B5388 leads from the town centre north-west and the field is about 2-3 miles along on the left. From the Yardley Hastings end the B5388 is a turning off the A428 just south east of Yardley Hastings and the field is a right turn about 1-2 miles along. Be aware there are new time/distance speed cameras on this road so be warned (for SatNav users MK46 5EJ will get you very near)
